

Free Trial of Phishing Simulation Terms and Conditions

1. **Eligibility:**
 - a. The free trial of the phishing simulation is available only to UK public sector organisations, or UK businesses with more than 250 employees.
2. **Duration:**
 - a. The trial will begin at a mutually agreed date and will continue for a limited period.
 - b. The trial period may be subject to change or termination at the discretion of the service provider without prior notice.
3. **Registration:**
 - a. To avail of the free trial, participants must complete the registration process by providing accurate and complete information.
 - b. Participants may be required to provide their name, organisation details, email address, and any other relevant information as requested during registration.
4. **Usage:**
 - a. The trial allows participants to access and utilise the phishing simulation service provided by the service provider.
